



## **Cargill Submission – GTA Standards Review – First Round**

Cargill makes the following submission in response to the GTA Member Update – First Industry Call for Submissions on 2018/19 GTA Standards document:

### **3.6 – Agreed Change: Snails – Barley**

Cargill supports the agreed change to reduce the tolerance for snails from 2 to 1 snail per half litre in the malt and F1 barley grades. This change will bring the main barley grades in line with the major milling grades for wheat and will close the gap between the tolerance applied on receipt of grain to that applied by the Department of Agriculture and Water Resources for grain exports.

### **4.2 Potential Change: Feed Grade Names – Barley**

Cargill supports the proposal to change the name of feed barley to reflect that it may be used for various end use purposes. Of the options presented in the paper Cargill believes the best option is to change the names of the current feed barley grades to General Purpose 1 and General Purpose 2.

If this change is adopted it should be implemented for the 2019/20 season to avoid potential contracting issues.
