Submission to GTA Standards Committee – Proposed changes to GTA Millrun Standard

MAURI is one of the largest domestic millers with sites across Australia and is a supporter of GTA and their standards. In collaboration with other industry participants we would like to propose the following changes to the current millrun standards in order to bring these standards in line with current industry practices.

1. **Standard Name** – Current standard is called “Mill/Run Wheat Offal – CSBP-2”. We would like to propose a name change to “Millrun, Millmix, Millfeed & Broll”. **Rationale** – the current description is not representative of what it is called in the industry. Name change brings this in line with industry standard.
2. **Description** – Current standard is “Consists of coarse wheat bran, fine wheat bran, wheat pollard, wheat flour”. Proposed description is “Consists of coarse wheat bran, fine wheat bran, wheat pollard, wheat flour, un-ground screenings, straw, wheat chaff, seeds”.
3. **Texture** – Current standard is “Grind shall be uniform and material free of any lumps”. Proposed texture is “Material should be uniform and free of any lumps indicative of water damage”.
4. **Nil Acceptance** – Current standards state “Not to contain any foreign materials such as un-ground screenings, straw, wheat chaff, seeds etc.”. We would propose that this statement is removed from the standard.
