Matthew's role as a Grain and Cotton Merchant involves accumulating commodities including wheat, barley, chickpeas, sorghum and cotton in QLD. He works in conjunction with traders, growers and brokers across numerous commodities to accumulate for one of the largest merchants in Australia.

His typical day begins with liaising with the trade desk and logistics staff in Melbourne to understand where, when and what we need to buy. Following this he communicates with brokers, consultants and growers to buy the commodities Viterra require. This may vary from buying chickpeas delivered to Mackay Port, wheat delivered to a Darling Downs Feedlot or cotton lint from a cotton gin in Moree.

Matthew's role requires he has in depth knowledge of Australian east coast supply and demand movements for grain and cotton alongside numerous contacts in the industry.
