Ref: Indian SPS Notice re Draft Plant Quarantine (Regulation of Import into India) (Third Amendment) Order, 2017.

#### 1. About Grain Trade Australia

Grain Trade Australia (GTA) is the focal point for the commercial grains industry within Australia. It facilitates trade and works to provide an efficient, equitable and open trading environment by providing leadership, advocacy and commercial services to the Australian grain value chain.

GTA members are responsible for over 95% of all grain storage and freight movements made each year in Australia. Over 95% of the grain contracts executed in Australia each year refer to GTA grain standards and/or trade rules. GTA members are drawn from all sectors of the grain value chain from production to domestic end users and exporters. GTA members are involved in grain trading activities, grain storage, grain for human consumption and stock feed milling.

A list of all members is attached.

Within this context, GTA provides comment on the abovementioned SPS notice from India for wheat (as attached).

#### 2. Seed for sowing

In relation to the following:

"3. Amendment of Schedule V- In the Schedule V to the Plant Quarantine (Regulation of Import into India) Order, 2003 against serial number 16 relating to Triticum spp. (Wheat) in column (3) against the entry (i), Seed for sowing".

GTA members do not supply wheat for sowing to India and GTA has no comment on this matter.

### 3. Seeds for Consumption

In relation to the following:

"4. Amendment of Schedule VI- In the Schedule VI to the Plant Quarantine (Regulation of Import into India) Order, 2003- (i) Against serial no.310, relating to Triticum spp. (Wheat) in column (3) against the entry (i) Grains for consumption for processing thereof and the entries relating thereto in columns (4), (5) and (6), the following item and entries shall respectively be inserted."

## 3.1 Ergot

In relation to the proposal, being:

Freedom from:

d) Claviceps purpurea (ergot)

As you may be aware, GTA was contacted in early 2017 by Dr Mahmood Nasir Plant Biosecurity, seeking comment on the nil tolerance for ergot in India's regulations. GTA via a Working Group provided a response to the submission proposed to be sent by the Australian government to the Indian government.

That response highlighted our significant concerns with the proposal indicating the nil tolerance for ergot was not considered warranted under quarantine regulations. In addition, the Department were made aware that a nil tolerance for ergot has significant negative impacts on the ability of the Australian grain trade to supply wheat to India from certain regions of the cropping belt.

While GTA did not see the final version of that submission, our views were accepted in the submission and we are lead to believe the submission was sent to the Indian government via the Australian government.

Prior to that submission, in late 2016 the Egyptian government also reviewed their ergot tolerance and industry again advised the Australian government of our concerns with their proposal for a nil tolerance for ergot. The Egyptian government eventually acceded to trade requirements and reverted to the internationally accepted and applied 0.05% tolerance by weight of ergot.

GTA members have not altered their views from those previously provided and we seek further Australian government intervention on this issue of ergot in wheat to India. To re-iterate, while industry currently complies with this requirement, GTA members do not agree with a nil tolerance as it is not technically justified from a quarantine perspective and it leads to significant trade disruptions. We urge you to provide Australian government comments reflecting both industry and governments opposition to this nil tolerance.

# 3.2 Fumigation

Mandatory fumigation requirements currently apply and are also considered in this SPS Notice as follows:

"Fumigation by Methyl Bromide at 32 g per cubic meter for 24 hrs at 21°C or equivalent thereof. The treatment shall be endorsed on Phytosanitary Certificate issued at the country of origin/re-export."

The Australian grain industry currently complies with this requirement for pre-shipment fumigation. We support the option for methyl bromide fumigation as listed continuing for wheat shipments from Australia. We also seek an option to be included by India for the use of alternative fumigants, being those registered in Australia and with appropriate registrations and MRLs internationally (i.e., Codex and India).

## 3.3 Other Pathogens

In relation to other pathogens we note the requirement for freedom from *Erwinia rhapontici* (rhubarb crown rot), *Pseudomonas atrofaciens* (spike rot) and *Pseudomonas fuscovaginae* (sheath brown rot)".

All three are present in Australia and therefore pose a risk to trade. All three do not meet the accepted international definition of a quarantine pest because they are not of 'potential economic significance'. They are weak pathogens of wheat and control measures are generally not necessary. Again, the Australian government have already provided a submission to India arguing this point. We request this again be reiterated in the Australian government response to this SPS notice.

GTA has no concerns with the other proposed changes.

For your information GTA has been liaising with other international grain industry associations who also share our concerns on several of these matters and are seeking to provide submissions on these issues through various industry and government sources.
