2. What is a Voluntary Administration?

A Voluntary Administration is a process initiated by the directors of a Co-operative when they believe that the Co-operative is, or is likely to become, insolvent. This means that the Co-operative is unable to pay its debts or is likely to become unable to pay its debts.

A Voluntary Administration gives a Co-operative an opportunity to consider its financial position and its future. Creditors will be given an opportunity to vote on the future of the Co-operative for one of the following statutory options:

(a) Enter into a formal arrangement with their creditors in respect of their debts (called a Deed of Cooperative Arrangement),

(b) Be placed into liquidation, or

(c) Return control of the Co-operative to the directors.

A Voluntary Administrator was appointed on 15 August 2022 to control a Co-operative's affairs.

- Particular note should be taken on the need to cover physical exposures as a result of financial settlement of contracts.

4. Changes to Insolvency / Ipso Facto Law

Please refer to <u>Member Update 12 of 18</u> which informs GTA Members of changes to the Ipso Facto law. This law came into effect from 1 July 2018.
