

TOPIC: 2022/32 Location Differentials for WA - Amendment to SA Location Differentials DISTRIBUTION: GTA Members – primary contact list. Please circulate to all appropriate internal parties.

1 Issue

The 2022/2023 <u>Western Australian Location Differentials (LDs)</u> have now been finalised post a review and endorsement by the GTA Commerce Committee and subsequent approval by the GTA Board. The GTA Board has also approved a change to the South Australian LDs that were released in <u>Member Update 21 of 22</u>. <u>*The revised SA LDs can be found here.*</u>

2 LDs in Western Australia

As per the Board approved LDs Standard Operating Procedure (SOP), LDs for sites in WA that have access to company owned seaport terminals (CBH and Bunge sites) are based off the relevant Estimated Freight Rates for the `se storage networks. The CBH Grower Freight Rate Schedule 22-23 and the Bunge freight rates for 2022/23 have been provided to GTA and reviewed by the Commerce Committee.

For non-CBH and Bunge sites, the agreed methodology (per SOP) "In WA where a site is not owned by CBH (or Bunge), the LD shall be calculated using the road distance to port of the particular site based on Google Maps based on the rate/t per km rate for the nearest CBH (or Bunge) site adjusted for distance." In WA the site where the LD is a GTA calculated value is Tamma Grain.

3 Amendment to SA LDs

The South Australian LDs including the T-Ports sites were approved by the Board at its September 2022 meeting.

GTA subsequently received an email requesting the T-Ports LDs are changed due to changed circumstances. The request was:

- Kimba to be changed from \$13.00 to \$14.00
- Lock to be changed from \$16.50 to \$18.00

This request was proposed to the GTA Commerce Committee and was supported and endorsed for the GTA Board consideration. The GTA Board subsequently approved the change.
