1 Issue

The 2021/2022 Western Australian Location Differentials (LDs) have now been finalised post a review and endorsement by the GTA Commerce Committee and subsequent approval by the GTA Board.

2 LDs in Western Australia

As per the Board approved LDs Standard Operating Procedure (SOP), LDs for sites in WA that have access to company owned seaport terminals (CBH and Bunge sites) are based off the relevant Estimated Freight Rates for these storage networks. The CBH Grower Freight Rate Schedule 21-22 and the Bunge freight rates for 2021/22 have been provided to GTA and reviewed by the Commerce Committee.

For non-CBH and Bunge sites, the agreed methodology (per SOP) "In WA where a site is not owned by CBH (or Bunge), the LD shall be calculated using the road distance to port of the particular site based on Google Maps based on the rate/t per km rate for the nearest CBH (or Bunge) site adjusted for distance." In WA the site where the LD is a GTA calculated value is Tamma Grain.
