TOPIC: IAN 2023-13: Plant Export Operations – Updated certificate requirements for grain and horticulture consignments to Republic of Korea and Bangladesh.

## 1. Purpose

This Industry Advice Notice (IAN) is to advise stakeholders that on 3 April 2023 we are changing the process for issuing non-GMO certificates for grain and horticulture consignments to Republic of Korea and Bangladesh.

## 2. Summary of changes and key points

- On 3 April 2023, the Certificate as to Condition (Grain GX46/Horticulture HX46) attesting to non-GMO status, replaced the current Declaration and Certificate as to Condition (EX188) for grain and horticulture consignments to Republic of Korea and Bangladesh.
- $\bullet \quad \text{The manual EX188 will no longer be issued for grain and horticulture consignments to Republic of Korea and Bangladesh.}\\$
- The Certificate as to Condition (Grain GX46/Horticulture HX46) will be issued as an extra certificate from EXDOC, on security paper, saving exporters time and money.
- Authorisation of the Request For Permit (RFP) can be requested by emailing Assessment Services Exports.
- Micor Plants cases will be updated to reflect the updated certification requirements.

## 3. Exporter responsibilities

Prior to 3 April 2023 exporters should access Micor Plants and familiarise themselves with updated certification requirements for grain and horticulture consignments to Republic of Korea and Bangladesh.
