## **Notice to Members**

Title: Review of GTA Location Differentials for the 2010/2011 season

**Update No.:** 10 of 10

**Date of Issue:** 30 April 2010

## **Background**

The GTA Transport, Storage and Handling Committee are reviewing the Location Differentials (LDs) for the 2010/2011 season. GTA Location Differentials are valid for 12 months and subject to review annually.

The current LDs are on the GTA website <a href="http://www.graintrade.org.au/location">http://www.graintrade.org.au/location</a> differential tables.

Prior to submitting a submission you are advised to read the Explanatory Memorandum which details how last years LDs were developed.

## 2 Recommendation

In relation to LDs for 2010/2011, the GTA Commerce Committee has made the following recommendations:

- There are no issues with the current LDs in WA and therefore it would be appropriate to use the Grain Express Freight Rates published by CBH for the 2010/2011 season.
- There are no issues with the current LDs in SA therefore it would be appropriate to use the Export Select Freight Rates published by Viterra for the 2010/2011 season.
- There are no issues with the current LDs in QLD, NSW and VIC therefore it would be appropriate to not change the current (ie the 2009/2010) QLD, NSW & VIC LDs for the 2010/2011 season.

## 3 **Review and implementation process**

- Feedback is sought from members on any issues industry feels relevant to the Location Differentials for 2010/2011.
- 2. Following receipt of feedback, the Transport, Storage and Handling Committee will consider all issues raised and prepare a final draft of the 2010/11 Location Differentials.
- 3. Following ratification by the GTA Board, the final Location Differentials will be published on the GTA website and available for industry use.
- 4. GTA LDS for QLD, NSW and VIC are effective from 1 October each year. The WA & SA Location Differentials will be advised when CBH's Grain Express values and Viterra's Export Select values are published.
- 5. All feedback from industry on the above issues must be received by GTA (admin@graintrade.org.au) by COB Friday 28th May 2010. In your email message line please put "Submission – Location Differentials 2010/2011".
