Title: GTA 2010/2011 Location Differentials

Background

The GTA Location Differentials for SA have been released and accordingly, GTA is able to publish the South Australian LDs.

Minor amendments have also been made to the NSW and VIC LDs.

South Australia

- All Viterra SA sites have been given an LD as per the Export Select rates published on 1 October 2010. These rates are effective 8/10/10.
- Kingscote (Kangaroo Island) has been given an LD of \$50. Members need to take this into consideration when pricing KI product.

Victoria

- Murrayville has been rated as “road “ only with no change to the LD or NTP.
- Werrimull and Walpeup (road only sites), although Viterra sites are in Victoria, hence their LD into Port Adelaide is determined as per all other Victorian sites.

New South Wales

- Previously AWB was given an LD for Warren which is no longer required and has been deleted.
- There was a LD variance between AWB and GrainCorp from Grong Grong to Port Kembla. This variance has been corrected to reflect the correct LD.

Western Australia

- All WA sites will be given an LD as per the Grain Express rates when published by CBH.

Changes to SA & WA 2010/11 Location Differentials

As outlined in GTA's 2010/2011 Location Differential's Explanatory Memorandum published on the GTA website, once published by GTA, the SA and WA LDs ***will not change during the course of the season***, irrespective of changes to Viterra's Export Select values or changes to CBH's Grain Express values.
