1. Background

The GTA Commerce Committee called for nominations and submissions for the GTA Location Differentials for the 2025/26 season on 10 February 2025 via <u>Member Update No. 1 of 25</u>. A total of four (4) submissions were received. The Commerce Committee has since met, and outcomes from the discussion of that submission can be found below. The Committee is now calling for further nominations or submissions on the listed issues. The current GTA Location Differentials can be found on the <u>GTA Website</u>.

2. Feedback & Action requested on Round 1 Submissions

A summary of Submissions received and the outcome of review and discussion by the Commerce Committee is provided in Table 1.

1.	Ulupna Pastoral Co Pty Ltd	Establishment of a LD for Ulupna Pastoral Co Grain Storage at Katunga, Victoria	Ulupna Pastoral Co has requested the establishment of a road-only Location Differential for its Grain storage at Katunga, Vic. The site is located 9km west of Katunga and 17km north of Numurkah. Melbourne is the designated NTP. In addition, the submission seeks to nominate also for the port of Geelong.	Committee reviewed the Submission and agreed to accept the proposed establishment of the LD for Ulupna Katunga , in the state of Victoria.
2.	Agconnex	Establishment of LDs for Agconnex grain storages in NSW at Benerembah, Carrathool, Coleambally and Wumbulgal.	Agconnex have taken over the grain storages previously operated by GrainLink NSW. The LD SOP states that when a site changes operational ownership, after application for an LD, the new operator will take up the prior LD values.	Committee reviewed the Submission and agreed to accept the proposed establishment of LDs for the Agconnex grain storages in NSW at Benerembah , Carrathool , Coleambally and Wumbulgal .

3.	Riordan Grain Services	Removal of LDs for the Stawell RGS grain storage.	RGS has requested the removal of the LD at the Stawell grain storage in Victoria as they have ceased as operator of the site.	Committee reviewed the Submission and agreed to remove the Stawell RGS LD.
4.	Viterra	Removal of LDs for Walpeup Viterra	Viterra has requested the removal of the LD at its Walpeup site as it is no longer operating.	Committee agreed to remove.
5.	Lapsed GTA Members	Removal of LDs at sites that are not operated by GTA members	The Committee has agreed to remove existing sites where the operator has ceased as a business or has a allowed their GTA membership to lapse.	 Committee reviewed the proposed sites and agreed to remove: Surat Bulk Grains site at Surat Qld Linx site at Forbes NSW Berriwillock grain site at Berriwillock Vic.

5. Special Notes

- Change in a Site Operating Company should be advised to GTA and new LDs requested
- Otherwise, Sites currently listed with a GTA LD do not need to be re-nominated to be listed in the coming 2025/26 season. GTA will assume these sites remain as listed
- Only GTA Members are entitled to nominate their sites for LDs
- All sites large or small, rail or road, are eligible for a GTA LD
- Sites should also be formally nominated to be withdrawn from the GTA LD schedule
